Seals and Stamps

The seals and stamps authorized for Land Surveyors in Board Rule 180-12-.01 may be of the crimp embossing type, rubber ink stamp, or may be computer generated. The seal design is to be circular in form, the diameter of the outer circle being 1-1/2 inches, and the diameter of the inner circle being one inch.

Following is a facsimile of the stamp/seal design approved by the Georgia Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors Board. Please see O.C.G.A. 43-15-22 and Board Rule 180-12-.01 for more information. Take the following facsimile to any office supply location for reference.



The seal or stamp should include the complete license number including the prefix and all the numbers. For example, an individual license number would be LS999999. The No. in each seal may be replaced with the LS prefix. You may change "Registered Land Surveyor" to Professional Land Surveyor" if you prefer. The name on the seal or stamp should be the same as the name you have on file with the Board if possible. Nicknames should be avoided. If you are known by a middle name, the first initial should be included on the seal or stamp.
