

Boundary Survey Plat Conformance Checklist

Adopted 2025 – Version 1.0

Please Note: Survey plats and drawings prepared in GA by licensed land surveyors must conform with the rules and laws as set forth in GAPELS Board Rule 180-7-.07 and OCGA § 15-6-67 (2023). This checklist has been developed to provide a reference tool for conformance with GA standards for boundary surveys. This checklist is not intended to be all-inclusive for all survey drawings or plats, and it is the responsibility of the land surveyor to know and apply all laws and board rules that may apply to their specific drawings. Notes or other requirements required by local or other governing jurisdictions or other survey standards are not covered by this checklist.

Boundary Line Evidence (Fences, Etc.)	□ County, City, State Lines, Etc
