

Per GA PELS Board Rule 180-2-.01(3), applicants for licensure as a Professional Land Surveyor in the State of GA must submit two boundary survey drawings and two topographic survey drawings with their final application package for licensure. These survey drawings must conform to GA state laws and minimum technical standards. Each of these drawings must have the following certification attached, signed and stamped by the professional land surveyor that managed and supervised the production of the survey drawings. *As a comity applicant for licensure in GA, the board requests you to edit existing surveys you have prepared in your home state to conform with the laws and regulations of GA for submittal.*
